All applications must be completely filled out and typed. Application may be hand written but the essay must be typed. Incomplete applications and or applications that do not follow guidelines will not be considered.

A committee will screen all applications.

Scholarship Requirements

1. Must have been a member of CTYRA for at least two years, including the current year. For example, if a student is applying for the 2026 scholarship, he/she must have been a member in good standing for the 2024-2025 season and the 2025-2026 season.
2. Must have participated in the finals in 2025 and be participating in the 2026 finals.
3. Must be a member in good standing.
4. Must be graduating high school or a current college student.
5. Must not have received this scholarship in the past.

Must Provide The Following

- A typed narrative essay setting forth accomplishments in both rodeo and extracurricular activities while in high school. The narrative should also describe the students proposed course of study and the college the member wants to attend.
- Proof of enrollment in an accredited high school, home school program or current college.
- An official high school or college transcript from the last semester.
- At least one letter of recommendation from a non-relative.
- A recent photo.
