**SCHOLARSHIP PREREQUISITES**

**1. APPLICATIONS**

All applications must be completely filled out in legible writing or typed. Incomplete applications and applications that do not follow the application form specifically will not be considered. A committee will screen all applications.

**2. SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS**

- A. Must have been a member of CTYRA for at least two years, including the year in which they are applying for a scholarship. For example, if a student is applying for the 2023-2024 scholarship, he or she must have been a CTYRA member in good standing for the 2022-2023 & 2023-2024 seasons.
- B. Must have participated in the finals in 2023 and participate in the finals 2024.
- C. Must be a member in good standing.
- D. Must be a graduating high school senior or a college student.
- E. Must not have received this scholarship before.

**3. MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:**

- A. The completed application.
- B. A typed narrative setting forth accomplishments in both rodeo and other high school extracurricular activities. THIS NARRATIVE MUST BE TYPED. IF IT IS NOT TYPED, IT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. The narrative should also describe the students proposed course of study and the college the student wants to attend.
- C. Proof of enrollment in an accredited high school, home study program or college.
- D. If a high school senior, an Official High School Transcript and copy of last semester grades.
- E. At least one letter of recommendation from a non-relative.

F. A recent photograph.

4. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION IS AT THE END OF THE CTYRA RODEO ON February 24, 2024

The application must be in the hands of Stephanie Shoemaker, the rodeo secretary by the end of the CTYRA rodeo on February 20, 2022. The applications can only be turned in to Stephanie Shoemaker. If it is delivered to any other person, IT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. Also, any application received after February 24,2024, even if it is postmarked prior to February 24, 2024, WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. NO EXCEPTIONS.
